(Lark Vale, Aylesbury)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER, 2018

BUCKINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL has made an Order, which will temporarily prohibit any vehicle from proceeding, except for access, in that length of Lark Vale, Aylesbury, which commences at a point located outside Cleveland Park Road and continues to a point located outside Lark Vale, a distance of approximately 21 metres.

The alternative route for vehicles affected by the closure will be via Lark Vale, Partridge Way, Watermeadow, Watermead, Buckingham Road, Elmhurst Road, Verwood Road, Cleveland Road, Cleveland Park.

The closure is required whilst Transport for Buckinghamshire works take place and it is anticipated that the works will commence on 20 August 2018 and will take approximately 104 days between 07:00 and 19:00 each day to complete. These works will take place for a duration of 5 days. 2 weeks advance warning will be notified prior to works taking place.

The Order will come into operation on 20 August 2018 when the appropriate signs are lawfully displayed and will continue for a period not exceeding eighteen months or until the said works have been completed whichever is the earlier.

Penalties for not observing these restrictions will be as prescribed by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and the Road Traffic Act 1991.
