

When you go away, it's sensible to leave your home as normal as possible, keeping your animals re-assured in their usual surroundings and avoiding kennel fees.



Don't be shy! We're all rather nice and it is a good way of meeting new friends and neighbours. We have a very interesting programme for the rest of the year. Any queries?


